A roundtable was conducted. The committee welcome Michelle Sultan as the new management representative for Vice-President, Academic & Provost. Members thanks René Houle for his contributions and membership on the committee.

#### 1. CRTF Presentation

Members welcomed Claude Laguë, who prior to the meeting provided written responses to members questions about the university's COVID-19 measures. A Q&A period followed with classroom HVAC discussed, continued promotion of 3<sup>rd</sup> vaccine dose and that there has been no specific discussion on what would occur if masking requirements are removed.

#### 2. JHSC Presentation

Bob Atkinson accepted a role within the Office of Risk Management as Risk Management Specialist, Occupational Health and Safety. He was invited to present a report for 2021. Common findings were presented from across all areas of the university.

#### 3. Approval of agenda

#### 4. Approval of the minutes from November 24, 2021

#### 5. Matters Arising from the November 24, 2021

- COVID-19
  - i. Response to members questions (rapid tests, local monitoring of CO<sup>2</sup> in occupied classrooms) from the meeting of November 21, 2021 were included as part of the questions at the beginning of the meeting.
- Terms of reference
  - i. Comments were incorporated and resent to members and union offices prior to the meeting for a 30-day comment period (ending March 23, 2022).
    - ACTION Members and union offices to provide feedback to <u>sst-ohs@uottawa.ca</u> within 30-days. An approval process will recommence.
- Occupational health and safety management system
  - i. Graham Nelson presented a brief summary of the work conducted to date by the project/steering committees, including the future state goals and guiding principles. Focus



is now on the operating model and RACI chart. A subset of committee members were involved at the start of the project with interested members invited to contact <a href="mailto:sst-ohs@uottawa.ca">sst-ohs@uottawa.ca</a> for more information.

- Roll out of workplace first aid program
  - i. CSA first aid kits continue being rolled out to faculties/services. Additional kits and 3 new AEDs have been ordered for ARC, STM and a 3<sup>rd</sup> building TBD.

#### 6. Critical Injury / Occupational Illness Report

Recent matters include the following:

- 200 Lees reported occupational illness (COVID-19). The Inspector verified policies and procedures in place for COVID-19. Scott Dick participated to follow-up. No order issued.
- Exterior Tabaret reported critical injury (fracture). Unknown at the time of the incident whether
  the incident occurred on campus. Upon investigation, the incident occurred on City of Ottawa
  property. The Inspector attended campus and accepted the employer's conclusion. Scott Dick
  participated to follow-up. Information on the snow program was provided. No order issued.
- 141 Louis-Pasteur reported occupational illnesses (COVID-19). The Inspector verified policies
  and procedures in place for COVID-19. Two worker members from the Facilities and Protection
  committee participated via telephone. No order issued.

#### 8. Functional Health and Safety Committee Minutes

- Office January 31, 2022 no matters of significance to discuss.
- Laboratory February 16, 2022 committee recently met and discussed autoclaves and the practices around their use. A request for information (location, practices, etc.) will be sent to the faculties of medicine, science and engineering.
- Facilities/Protection <u>September 23, 2021</u>, November 25, 2021, February 10, 2022 no matters of significance to discuss.
- Alta Vista November 12, 2021, January 18, 2022 no significant matters to discuss.
- Psychological December 2, 2021, January 26, 2022 discussion on the forthcoming right to disconnect policy. No regulations published as of yet, therefore, difficult to appreciate scope. Work continues on this front through Human Resources.

#### 9. New Business

- WSIB Safety Excellence Program
  - i. uOttawa successfully completed 4 topics (COVID-19, health and safety training, injury reporting and workplace first aid) which means uOttawa qualifies for a rebate from the WSIB insurance premium. The rebate will be reinvested into the OHS program.
- Annual report
  - An annual report has been prepared summarizing the 2021 year in occupational health and safety. A brief overview was presented during the committee with the full report to be circulated in the coming days.



- Next meeting
  - i. In line with the phased return to campus, a discussion ensued on the format of the next meeting (in-person/virtual/bi-modal). Co-chairs will explore options for bi-modal option with an entirely virtual meeting remaining a possibility.
