These credits will count as optional courses in LCL and CLA.

<sup>3</sup> The courses **CLA2153** and **CLA2154** are abolished. Students who have completed **CLA2153** and **CLA2154** are exempted from CLA2121 and will receive 3 credits CLA2XXX. These credits will count as optional courses in LCL and CLA. Students who have completed only one of CLA2153 or CLA2154 will receive 3 credits CLA2XXX. These credits will count as optional courses in LCL and CLA.
