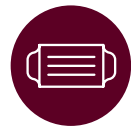
The Residence Life team helps create a safe community in which residents of all backgrounds and orientations thrive both academically and personally.

Community advisers (CAs) are upper-year students who live on your floor and foster a community atmosphere.



Our commitment is to offer you a memorable residence experience in a *safe* and *healthy* environment.

In consultation with local health authorities, we've put in place the following measures.



Mandatory masks

Masks or face coverings are required when you're with others and in common areas.



Mandatory COVID-19 training

All residents must complete comprehensive training before moving into residence.



Self-isolation spaces and protocols

If there's a possible or confirmed case of COVID-19, residents are supported throughout the self-isolation process.



Enhanced cleaning procedures

High-touch surfaces and common areas are cleaned and disinfected more often.



Physical distancing

Floor decals, directional signage and capacity limits in common areas are prominently featured to ensure everyone keeps a two-metre distance from others.



Protective barriers

Plexiglass barriers have been installed at residence reception and the Dining Hall checkout.



Residence Life activities

Our ResLife team members continue to offer an enriching community experience and support services. They've adopted a flexible approach, with in-person activities that comply with physical distancing regulations and virtual activities.



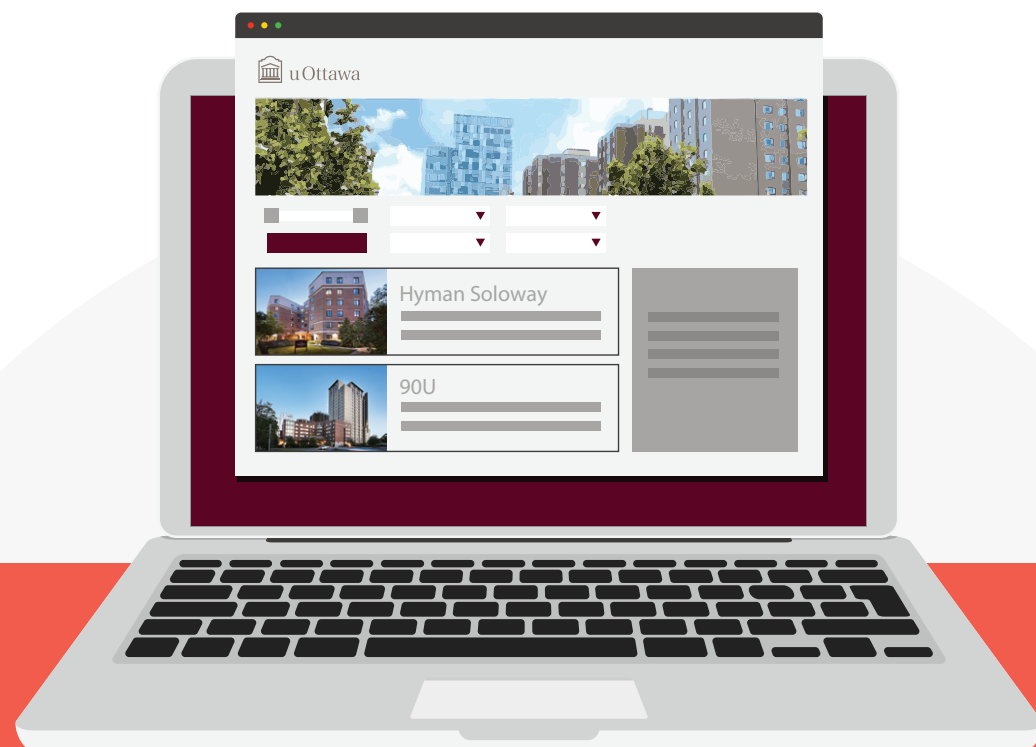

Guaranteed housing for first-year students*

To benefit from the housing guarantee, you must:

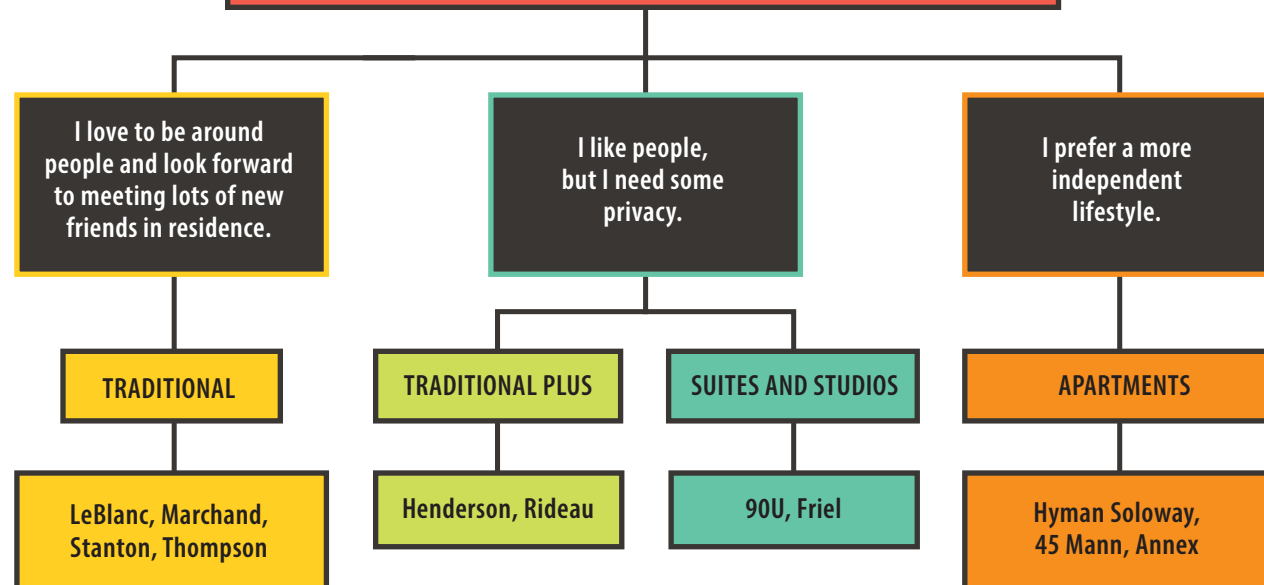
- 1 Be admitted to an undergraduate program starting in the fall
- 2 Submit your residence application and pay your \$700 deposit by the June 1, 2021 deadline

*This guarantee does not apply if you have already completed more than five university courses or the equivalent, or if you have been admitted to a professional program. Students from CEGEP or college admitted in second year can also benefit from the housing guarantee.

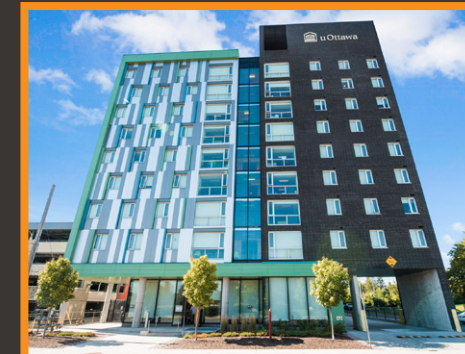

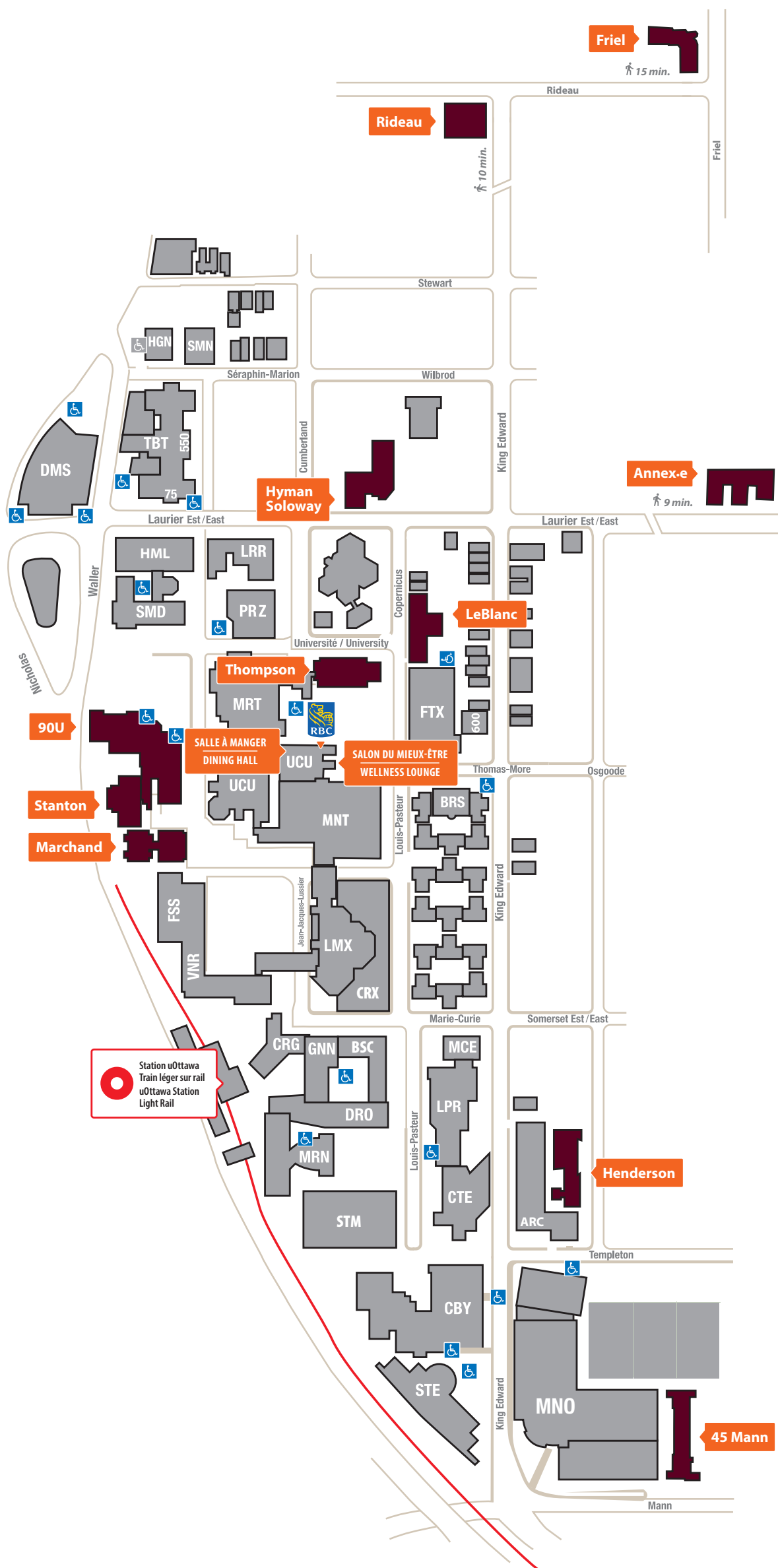
