- In 2015, we partnered with the Office of Campus Sustainability to implement a pen recycling program on campus.
- Working with Information Technology Services to ensure Energy Star compliance for all computers and servers on campus
- Working with Facilities to ensure green standards for all furniture purchased
- Working with Food Services to reduce waste and purchase more local food
