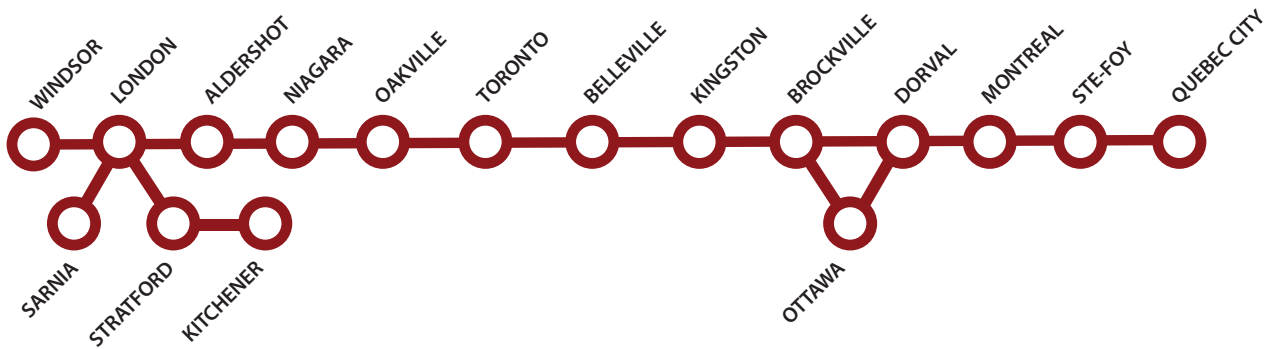
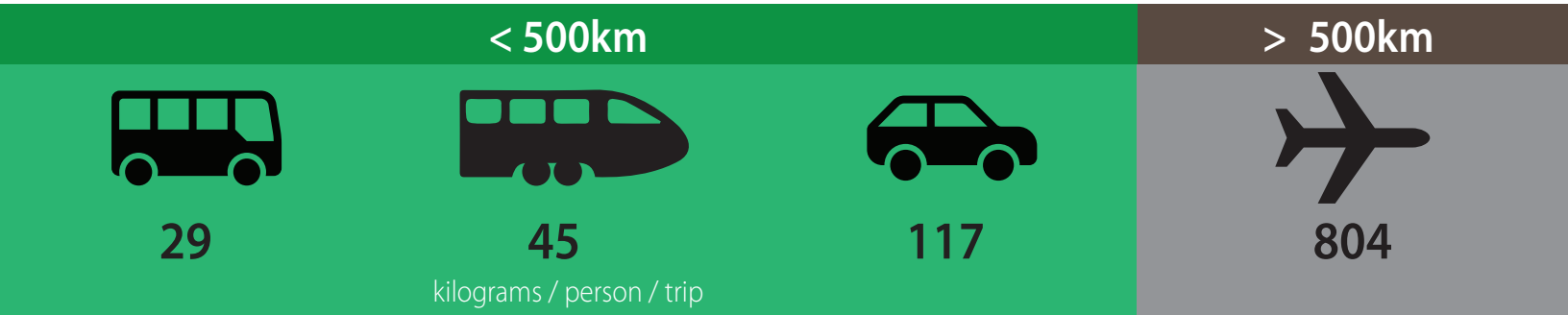




# Sustainable Events Guide: Travel guide

A big contributor to the environmental footprint of your event is the amount of greenhouse gas emissions created by travel. Buses and trains produce far fewer emissions per passenger when travelling fewer than 500 kilometers. This makes sense if you live along the Quebec - Windsor corridor. Encourage your participants to use sustainable forms of transportation to travel by suggesting the following alternatives.

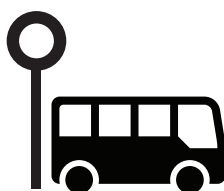

<b>4</b> <b>AIR TRAVEL</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Try to reduce the number of layovers</li> <li>Purchase credits</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Share public transportation details to travel from the airport to the campus</li> </ul>
