

Guaranteed housing for first-year students*

To benefit from the housing guarantee, you must:

- 1 Be admitted to an undergraduate program starting in fall 2025.
- 2 Submit your residence application and pay your \$1,000 deposit by June 2, 2025.

*This guarantee doesn't apply if you've already completed more than five university courses or the equivalent, or if you've been admitted to a professional program. Students from CEGEP or college admitted in second year can also benefit from the housing guarantee.


