Gain a global legal perspective

Each spring since 2001, Queen's Law has offered intensive and integrated programs in International Business Law (IBL) and Public International Law (PIL). This year the programs will begin with 3 weeks at Queen's in Kingston followed by 5 weeks based at Bard College in Berlin.

8-Week Program, 9 Credits

Each program consists of 3 3-credit upper-year courses taught by leading practitioners and academics. The courses, guest speakers, and program activities give students a comprehensive and practical introduction to international law.

Visit international courts and organizations, law firms, and Canadian missions in Paris (IBL) or The Hague (PIL) and Geneva (both programs).
