

Decision: Should I fast-track into the nursing PhD program or finish my MScN first?

This is to help you make this decision.

At uOttawa, graduate students enrolled in the Master's in nursing program (MScN) are eligible to apply to fast-track into the doctoral nursing program (PhD) without writing a master's thesis, if they have completed the core master's courses with a CGPA > 8.0 and a professor is willing to be their supervisor. Why are you thinking about Fast-Tracking?

When do you need to make a choice? The transfer must take place by the end of the fourth term of study at the latest. The application deadline for such a transfer is the first Monday of May.
