Passive language ability is defined as both oral and reading comprehension sufficient to participate actively in courses. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that they meet the language requirements for admission. Students will be required to submit proof of language proficiency as part of their admission package (See the <u>Graduate Studies: Application for admission</u>'s website in Step 2, section C for information on the documents that will need to be provided).
