Legal Writing Academy Portfolio and Leadership is a three-credit course for 10-12 upper-year students with excellent writing and interpersonal skills.

Students will produce high quality legal documents to showcase to future employers. Students who demonstrate outstanding writing and interpersonal skills will be eligible to become paid Legal Writing Academy Peer Mentors during the academic year.

Include:

1. Cover Letter: A two-paragraph cover letter saying why you want to be a writing leader and why you would be a good writing leader. Please let us know your preferred session. If you are applying for the Spring session, keep in mind that the course will be counted as one of your Fall 2021 courses. Short-listed candidates may be interviewed.
2. References: In your cover letter, including the names and phone numbers of two references. At least one should be a common law faculty member. **Do not include reference letters.**
3. Transcript: Informal transcripts are acceptable. First-year students please include interim grades.
4. CV: No longer than two pages.
5. Writing Sample: Five pages of legal writing (not a factum) that demonstrate your writing skills. This can be a cohesive portion of a longer piece.

Selections for the Spring 2022 session will be made by April 11, 2022.

Selections for the Fall 2022 and January 2023 sessions will be a week before the June 21 registration date for other 2022-2023 courses.

This course is by application only and is NOT listed under the on-line registration website. Once selected, the Academic Office will register students into the course.
