## **DCL7033: DIRECTED RESEARCH PAPER**

### **Information/Procedures**

**\*\*\* Only in the most exceptional of circumstances and subject to the approval of the graduate office of the Faculty of Law will a directed reading course be accepted.**

#### **Registration procedure:**

Students interested in registering for a Directed Research must submit, to the Office of Graduate Studies of the Faculty of Law:

- ✓ the "REQUEST DCL7033- DIRECTED RESEARCH" form properly completed and signed
- ✓ a research description (approximately 500 words)
- ✓ registration form (available at : <https://llm.phd.uottawa.ca/en/current-students> )

#### **Deadline to submit a request for a directed research:**

#### **Course description:**

This is a 10,000-word research conducted under the direction of a professor approved by the Graduate Studies Office.

The work is evaluated by the person who directed it.

The Directed Research Paper is a research activity that is to be completed in one semester.

#### **SCHEDULE:**

The schedule of meetings is organized directly between the student and supervisor.

#### **DEADLINE TO SUBMIT THE DIRECTED RESEARCH FOR EVALUATION:**

#### **METHOD OF EVALUATION:**

The supervising professor must submit the " EVALUATION DCL7033 – DIRECTED RESEARCH" form to the Graduate Studies Office of the Faculty of Law within 10 days of the submission.

An alphanumeric mark will be awarded for 10,000 words written work (40 pages)
