| How to get a Faculty ID Card | All faculty members except APUO members | <p>Option 1) Walk-Ins: Faculty members are invited to come to the Dean’s office between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. The entire process will take about 15 minutes. We verify that the personal information on file is accurate and then proceed to take your photo. The photo and personal information are sent to the human resources department on main campus for processing / developing. Once the card is ready, faculty members can chose to pick up their card at the Dean’s office or have it mailed to their department chair’s office.</p> <p>Option 2) Faculty members may send a headshot along with a copy of an official ID card (driver’s license / Health Card or any govt. ID card with a photo) to the Dean’s office at infomed@uottawa.ca. The Faculty uses the govt. ID card to verify the personal information on file and to confirm the faculty member’s identity. The photo and personal information are sent to the human resources department on main campus for processing / developing. Once the card is ready, the Faculty ID card will be sent to the faculty member’s office.</p> |
