The Albion Road practice was established in 1984 by Dr. Christiane Kuntz. This solo family practice is located in a suburban three-bedroom bungalow in the neighbourhood in which Dr. Kuntz grew up. Many of her patients she has known since childhood and in some cases she cares for three and occasionally four generations in one family. Dr. Kuntz has a working knowledge of English, German and French.

The practice roster of approximately 1500 patients makes it possible to see about 25 people in a full day. This is a pace that lends itself well to a teaching practice. Psychotherapy/counselling sessions involve supportive care for depressed and anxious patients, as well as dealing with addiction, childhood abuse, learning disabilities, childhood/adolescent behavioural problems and marital/sexual counselling. Dr. Kuntz also does shared care for obstetrics (no deliveries).

A typical work week would also involve house calls, supportive care of hospitalized patients and regular committee work. Dr. Kuntz spends two half days per week in mature women's health. She acts as the liaison between family medicine and the Shirley E. Greenberg Women's Health Center (SEGWHC) located at the Riverside Hospital. At SEGWHC she does consulting work involving the care of (peri)menopausal women and those with mood disorders, particularly PMS.

Special Interests: Women's Health, Mental Health (especially PMS and perimenopausal mood disorders) Patient Population: Roster of approximately 1500 patients (25 patients in a full day, 15 half day) Specialty Procedures: All minor procedures, lumps and bumps, IUD insertion, pessary fitting, breast cyst aspiration, deroofing hemorrhoids, some joint injections (PGY3s – Dr. Lindsay Bradley, sports medicine)
