Located in beautiful downtown Ottawa, Centretown Community Health Centre is a non-profit, multi-service organization established in 1969. Our premises were fully renovated in 2019. Family medicine residents have the opportunity to practice in an inter-professional environment where learners are valued team members. The primary care team includes family doctors, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, social workers, dietitians, chiropody, diabetes educators, lung health and outreach workers. We provide a full range of health and social services to families and individuals who live in the community we serve with an integrated approach to care that is holistic, non-discriminatory, and innovative.

As a busy interdisciplinary teaching site, clinical preceptors participate in the training of medical students, residents, nurse practitioner and nursing students. Our family medicine residents frequently work with other learners and are given the opportunity to develop teaching and mentorship skills.

Our medical team provides comprehensive, patient-centred care including:

- across the life cycle (maternal/newborn, child and adolescent, adult, elderly, palliative)
- varied clinical settings (pre-booked or same day office and virtual appointments, home visits)
- specialty clinics (Obstetrics, Well Baby, Urban Outreach, Transgender, New Canadians)
- procedural medicine (suturing, skin biopsy, cryotherapy, pap smears, intrauterine device, endometrial biopsy, joint and bursa injection, intramuscular and subcutaneous injection)
