Application Form - Hematological Pathology Elective for University of Ottawa Medical Students

Objectives: At the completion of the elective, the student will be able to recognize significant hematological processes on peripheral blood films and bone marrows. As well, the student will have an appreciation of the role of the transfusion medicine laboratory and coagulation laboratory in patient care in a tertiary teaching hospital.

Description: The student will examine blood films and marrows on patients seen at the hospital. Instruction will be both by attendance at rounds (lymphoma rounds, leukemia rounds) and by participation in the daily sign-out of peripheral blood and marrows, at a double-headed or multiheaded microscope. Emphasis will be on the recognition of anemia, leukemia and platelet disorders, their courses and further investigations. Introduction to the transfusion medicine laboratory and coagulation laboratory will also be available for interested students.
