Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to define the educational requirements when a rotation is deemed unsuccessful by the Residency Program Committee (RPC).

Policy:

An unsuccessful rotation as decided by the RPC, normally leads to an automatic extension of training of a minimum of 4 weeks extension with one noted exception:

- 1) If the resident is a PGY1, otherwise is in good academic standing, the deficiency is minor, and there are no issues related to professionalism or patient safety, the RPC may allow the resident to use an elective to remediate the educational deficiency. To be considered minor, the deficiency must be deemed by the RPC to be able to be successfully remediated within a 4-week time period. This can only occur one time within a residency.
