## Purpose:

To define the access to an educational fund for residents who contribute to undergraduate medical education teaching.

## **Policy:**

A stipend is provided in recognition of the resident's time and effort invested towards the educational mission of the Faculty of Medicine.

These funds can be used for:

- 1. Medical textbooks and medical journal subscriptions
- 2. Medical software
- 3. Medical courses, conferences, workshops
- 4. Computer, PDA or other electronic equipment
- 5. Transportation costs incurred for travel to and from courses, workshops or conferences
- 6. Accommodation costs incurred while attending courses, workshops or conferences.
- 7. Cost associated to exam fees and elective related expenses.

Funds can be accessed by submitting original receipts to the PGY1/PGY2/PGY3 Coordinator at the Department of Family Medicine.

Funds must be claimed prior to graduating.

## Applicability:

This policy applies to all residents (PGY1, PGY2 and PGY3)
