Summary of possible options

Take the Self-Evaluation Test: Test to be completed online (25 questions).

If a successful grade <u>is obtained</u> (17/25 or higher), you are exempted from completing the course MAT 1318 and you may proceed with one of the following options:

Options	What to do	When	Note
Option 1	Challenge Exam MAT1339	2 p.m. to 5 p.m. (In-person at	Required grade of 65%. If not successful, you must take the course in the Fall term. You must inform your faculty of your intention to write the challenge exam no later than August 15, 2024.
Option 2	Complete the course MAT1339 at uOttawa or its equivalent (MCV4U) at the Independent Learning Center	Summer term	You will be able to register to your first university calculus in the Fall term (no delay in your course sequence).
Option 3	Complete the course MAT1339 at uOttawa	Fall term	You will not be able to register in your first university calculus in the Fall term (delay in your course sequence).

■ If you <u>do not attempt</u> the Self-Evaluation Test <u>or</u> the successful grade is <u>not obtained</u> (16/25 and lower), you may proceed with one of the following options to successfully complete the two requirements by April 30th of your first year:

Option 1	Complete the course MAT1318 or its equivalent (summer) and the course MAT1339 (Fall) Note: MAT 1318 – This course will not be offered at uOttawa during the Summer 2023 term. It is possible to complete the equivalent course (MHF4U) at the Independent Learning Center.	Summer and Fall terms
Option 2	Complete the course MAT1318 (Fall) and the MAT1339 (Winter)	Fall and Winter terms
