ANNUAL REVIEW CRITERIA

In applying the following criteria, the Committee will take into account individual circumstances, such as parental leaves, health-related leaves of absence, and changes in thesis supervisors.

The general criteria used by the Committee for students in different years in the program will be the following:

<u>Year 1</u>: • Satisfactory performance in obligatory courses.

Please note that satisfactory performance in the Master's level research practicum is evaluated by the supervisor by the end of August.

- Year 2: Satisfactory performance in *all* of the following:
 - obligatory courses
 - supplementary clinical courses
 - foundational courses
 - clinical practica

Information about thesis progress should be fully described in the Annual Research Progress Report.

- <u>Year 3</u>: Satisfactory performance in supplementary clinical courses, foundational courses, and clinical practica
 - For students who entered the program in the Fall 2020, Successful completion of the thesis proposal and approval by the thesis committee
 - For students who entered the program before Fall 2020, substantial progress towards preparation of the thesis proposal as demonstrated by *at least one* of the following:
 - progress in data collection
 - a draft of the proposal submitted to the supervisor
 - a meeting of the thesis committee with a report on the outcome of the meeting and timelines agreed to by the committee

Information about thesis progress should be fully described in the Annual Research Progress Report.

- <u>Year 4</u>: Satisfactory performance in supplementary clinical courses, foundational courses, and clinical practica
 - For students who entered the program before Fall 2020, successful completion of the thesis proposal and approval by the thesis committee committee

Information about thesis progress should be fully described in the Annual Research Progress Report.

- Year 5: Satisfactory performance in clinical practica and courses
 - Satisfactory progress on the thesis beyond work completed in year 4 *Information about thesis progress should be fully described in the Annual*

Research Progress Report.

• Satisfactory performance in the internship (if applicable).

Year 6:
