Not all professors who are authorised to supervise honours thesis projects are available every year because of sabbatical leaves or special projects, duties and commitments.

Information regarding the availability of professors will be communicated to the students Mid-March. The maximum number of students that professors plan to supervise is added to the list (see the number beside the name of the supervisor).
