

Mental Health Trainee Researcher Awards

The University of Ottawa Brain and Mind Research Institute (uOBMRI) is pleased to announce the Trainee Researchers in Mental Health Awards request for applications. The purpose of these awards is to support both basic science and clinical researcher trainees conducting research in mental health. A maximum of two awards will be made.

How to apply:

1. Fill out the **application information form** found below.
2. Submit (in English or French) :
 - a **lay summary** of your proposed research (200 words max)
 - a **research summary** (1 page max, excluding references) explaining the proposed research project related to mental health. Include a brief background, research questions, and methodology
 - your **proposed training experience** (1 page max) describing how the proposed research and involvement with the uOBMRI will advance your training and career goals.
3. Attach up to date **school transcripts, two letters of reference** and your **CV** (limit of 2 pages).

The lay summary, research summary, proposed training experience, and CV documents should be *single spaced, 12-point font with 1" margins*. Please submit your complete application, in **one PDF** file, to Sarah Schock sschock@uottawa.ca. *Reference letters can be sent separately.*

Competition deadline: Friday May 27, 2022, 11:59 pm

Eligibility criteria:

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected/refugee status or an international student;
2. be a graduate student (MA/MSc or PhD level), a post-doctoral fellow, a medical student, or medical resident at one of the uOBMRI affiliated partners including Carleton;
3. demonstrate academic excellence;
4. conduct research relating to mental health that is supervised by a researcher at one of the uOBMRI affiliated partners including Carleton; and
5. not hold other awards (e.g. NSERC, CIHR, SSHRC) if they accept this award.

Funding amount: \$10,000 for 1 year (not renewable, but trainees can apply to future competitions).

Award conditions:

Recipients must:

- Present the results of their research at a meeting of the Mental Health Thematic Priority Area
- Participate in at least one uOBMRI fundraising initiative
- Participate regularly in uOBMRI trainee events and activities
- Participate in at least one uOBMRI networking or community engagement initiative
- Submit an abstract to at least one relevant national or international conference
