## Eligibility and Terms for all Fellowships:

Applicants must be Graduate students who work for members of the uOttawa Brain and Mind Research Institute working in Parkinson's disease research.

The tenure of the awards is:

- **Shelby Hayter Fellowship:** Two years at \$15,000 per year
- **Larry Haffner Fellowship:** Two years at \$15,000 per year
- **Dave and Jill Hogg Family Fellowship:** One year at \$15,000
- **Bonnie & Don Poole Parkinson's Research Fellowship:** One year at \$15,000
- **Francis Mathew Memorial Fellowship:** One year at \$15,000
- **The Michael Bell and family Foundation Fellowship:** One year at \$15,000

These awards are non-renewable. A student cannot apply for the same Fellowship they have already been awarded. However, they can apply for the others, but are limited to only 2 years of funding.

Awards will be given to Graduate students working on projects directly related to PD research.

**Note:** Fellowship funding support will be approved based on a 1/3 match. This match may come from the home Institution or via Supervisor/PI support. A letter of support for said 1/3 match is to accompany the application.

### Review Process:

The application deadline is **May 17th** and the following documents must be submitted electronically in one PDF to Sarah Schock at [sschock@uottawa.ca](mailto:sschock@uottawa.ca);

Applications will be reviewed by a scientific review committee and the PRC Advisory Board

- Application form face sheet
- Complete CV – limit of 2 pages
- A ½ page personal statement of the research to be performed
- 1 page scientific proposal
- 2 letters of reference (*can be sent separately*)
- Institutional or Supervisor letter of support committing to 1/3 match

### Other Criteria:

- Recipients will be asked to present their work at one of the bi-monthly PRC Research in Motion series and/or PRC Advisory Board meetings throughout the year.
- To support the PRC, recipients will be expected to attend PRC events and initiatives.
